THE GOVERNOR'S PROPOSED BUDGET WOULD CAUSE NEARLY 300,000 CHILDREN TO LOSE MEDI-CAL COVERAGE

The Medi-Cal Program provides needed health care services to more than 6 million Californians. Governor Schwarzenegger proposes to require families to submit paperwork four times annually for their children to retain access to Medi-Cal services. The Administration estimates that the new paperwork requirements would cause nearly 300,000 children to lose Medi-Cal coverage by 2009-10, including more than 150,000 in 2008-09.
