## THE GOVERNOR'S PROPOSED BUDGET WOULD CUT PAYMENTS TO MEDI-CAL PROVIDERS

The Medi-Cal Program provides needed health care services to more than 6 million Californians. Governor Schwarzenegger proposes a 10 percent reduction in payments to many providers of health care services in the Medi-Cal Program – such as doctors, hospitals, clinics, and managed care plans. The Governor's proposed reductions would result in total General Fund savings of more than \$650 million in 2007-08 and 2008-09 combined, but also would cause the state to lose a similar amount of federal funds. In February, the Legislature approved a 10 percent rate cut for a narrower set of Medi-Cal providers effective July 1; however, legislators have indicated they may reconsider that decision when they develop the 2008-09 budget.
