THE GOVERNOR'S REVISED BUDGET WOULD PREVENT MORE THAN 400,000 PARENTS FROM OBTAINING MEDI-CAL COVERAGE

The Medi-Cal Program provides needed health care services to more than 6 million Californians. Governor Schwarzenegger proposes to roll back Medi-Cal eligibility for low-income working parents by lowering the maximum income level to 61 percent of the poverty line (\$10,736 for a family of three in 2008) and making a related change. The Administration estimates that, when fully implemented, the proposal would reduce the number of low-income parents eligible for Medi-Cal by more than 400,000.
