## One-Quarter of California Children Receive Food Assistance, and In Some Counties the Level Is Nearly One-Half

**Percentage of Children Under 18 Receiving CalFresh Benefits** 

In 2013, one in four California children (24.8) were receiving CalFresh benefits — a level more than twice as high as that for the state population overall (11.1). While striking, this statistic actually masks wide variation among counties. For example, in Tulare and Fresno counties, nearly half of residents under 18 receive CalFresh, while in Marin, Placer, and Mono counties, just under 10 percent do. Yet even the lowest county rate of children receiving CalFresh (9.2 percent in Marin) is more than twice as high as that for the county population overall. These data underscore the fact that children are more likely to live in poverty than adults.
