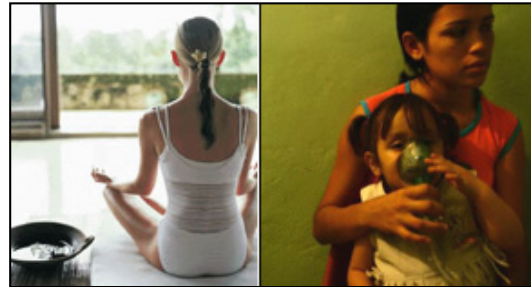

## Laws enacted by the legislature in recent past

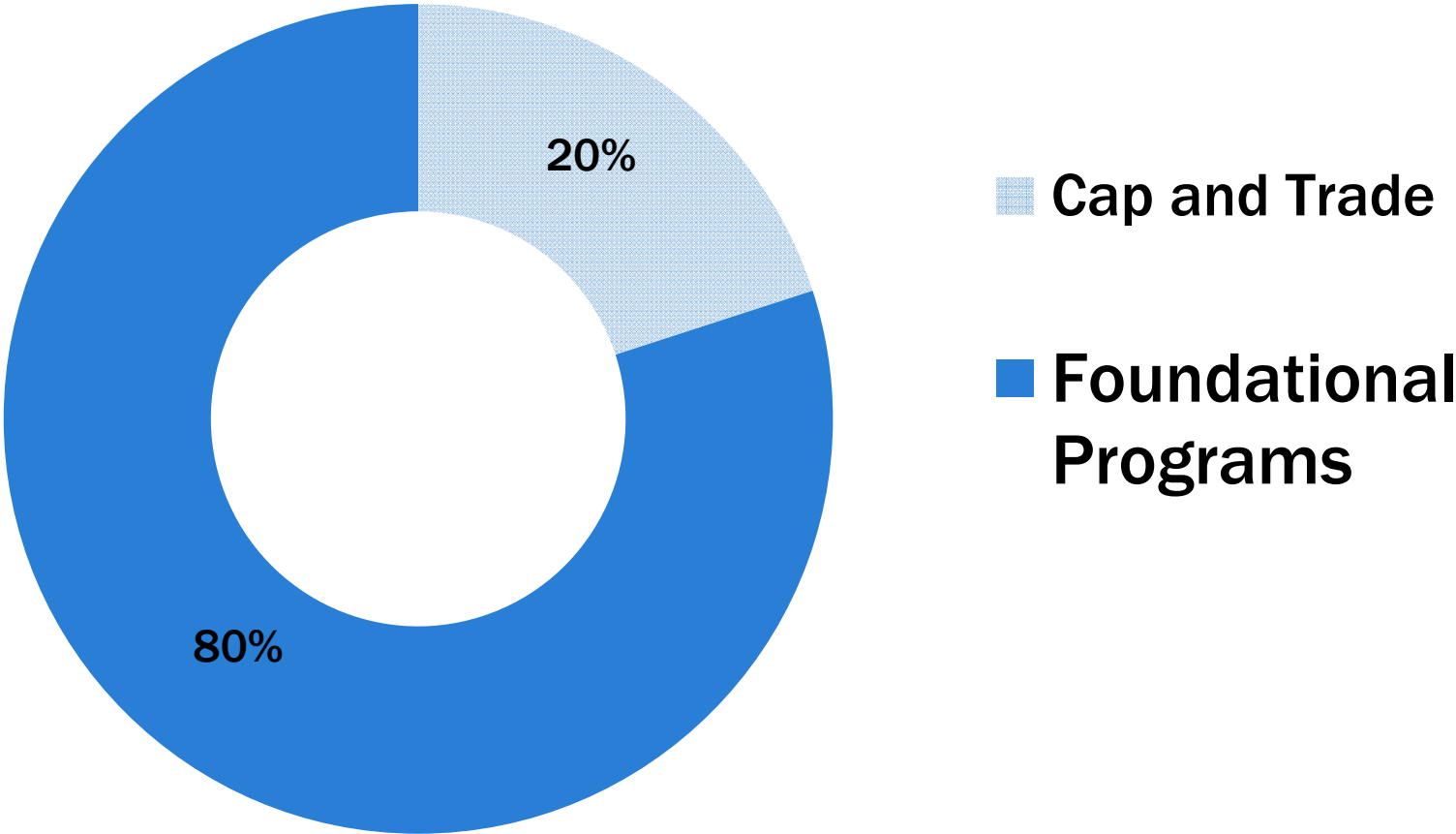
### Some examples:

- SB 32/AB 197



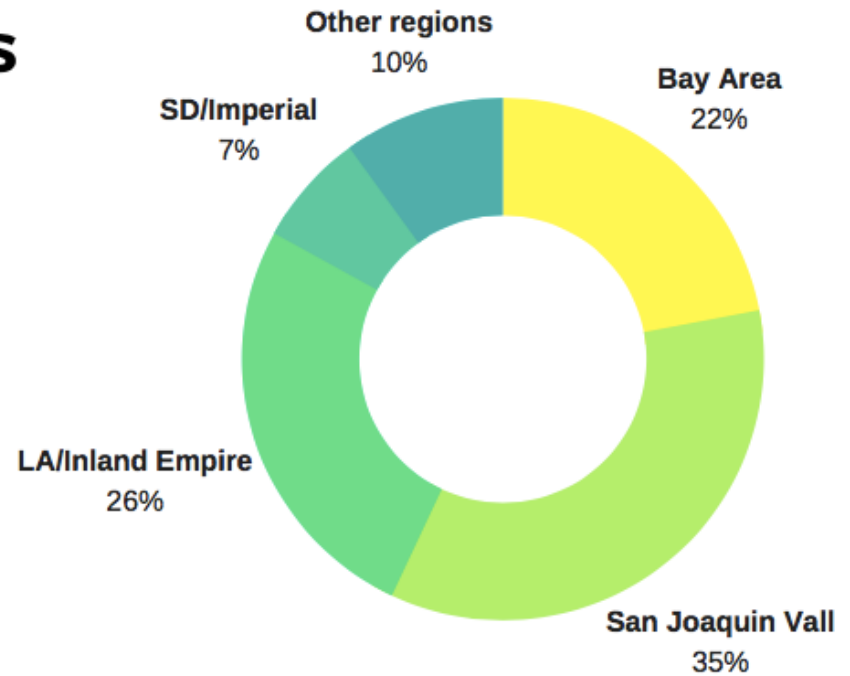
# How California Reduces GHG Emissions

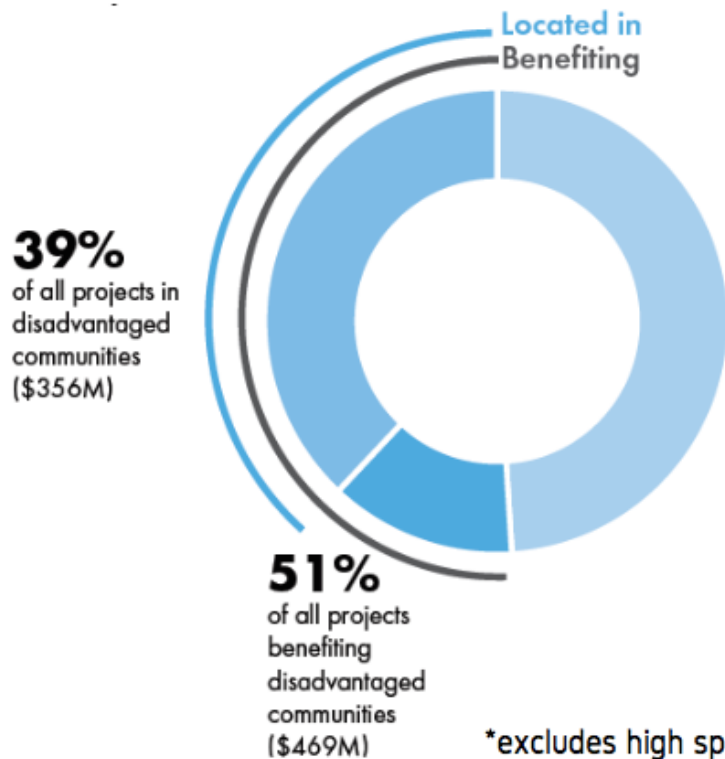

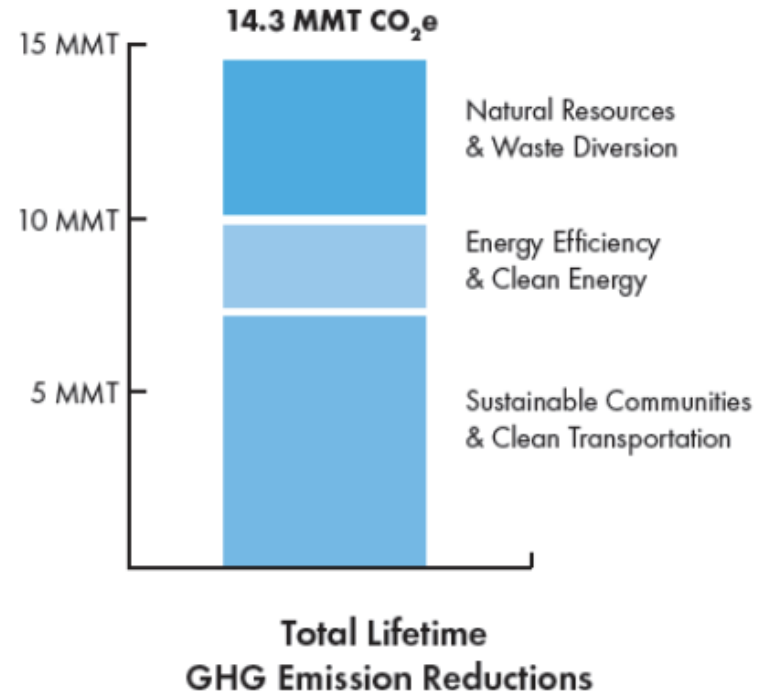

1. **Stable Revenue**
