



## California Women's Well-Being Index County Fact Sheet: Sacramento

The California Women's Well-Being Index provides a comprehensive, composite measure of how women are faring in each of the state's 58 counties. The Index encompasses five "dimensions" — Health, Personal Safety, Employment & Earnings, Economic Security, and Political Empowerment — each of which is made up of six indicators. This fact sheet shows the Index and dimension scores, indicator data, and state rankings for Sacramento County.
